Youth Protection Training

Youth protection training is 90 minute training session for parents and adult Scout leaders designed to accomplish two things: 1) ensure that all leaders and parents are equipped with the information needed to protect Scouts from physical, sexual, and emotional abuse, and 2) ensure that all leaders are informed of policies and procedures developed by the Boy Scouts of America to both protect Scouts and to minimize the likelihood that an adult leader will be falsely accused of abuse.

This important training is provided in Saddleback District on the third Tuesday evening of each month at the LDS Church located at [27976 Marguerite Parkway, Mission Viejo](#) starting promptly at 7:30. Pre-registration is not required, and the training is free. All that is asked is that you be on time and be prepared to learn as much as possible about one of the most important issues for parents and adult leaders, safeguarding the welfare of our youth.

Scouting for Food

Nov. 4-11, 2006

What?

Scouting for Food is a service project sponsored by the Boy Scouts of America, Orange County Council and the Girl Scout Council of Orange County.

Who?

All Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts and their units organize food drives in their community, at their school or church and collect food from their neighbors. Scouts are encouraged to fill five grocery bags full. Scouting for Food benefits Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County. Sponsors include Albertson's, ConAgra and the Orange County Register.

When?

Items may be collected at any time during Scouting for Food Week November 4-11, 2006, and outside Albertson's stores on Collection Day, Saturday, November 11. All food must be delivered to Pack 727 drop-off site at the home of Tasia and Bill Surch, 21 ARCILLA, (near Melinda Heights School) between 8:00 am and 12 Noon on Collection Day.

Where?

Orange County! Your neighborhood! This giant food drive supports Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County by serving hungry people in Orange County.

Why?

Both Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts are committed to helping where they are needed. Every can and box of food helps. Last year 182,050 pounds of food were collected.

How?

Get involved. It's as easy as 1-2-3. Collect food. Volunteer. Check out the Food Bank.

Three Steps to Scouting for Food

1. Collect items from family, friends, and neighbors.

All Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts are encouraged to collect five bags full of food. Preprinted grocery bags will be available from your service unit in October or November. Boy Scout units may also wish to coordinate food drives in their community, through their charter organization or schools. All food collected must be delivered to a drop-off site on Collection Day, November 11.

2. Volunteer with your troop/group at an Albertson's store.

Morning and afternoon shifts are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts in uniform will solicit donations and collect food from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on November 11 at Albertson's grocery stores throughout the county. A list of Albertson's stores are available in this packet.

1. Explore Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County.

Arrange an outing for your troop to visit the Food Bank and take a tour. Find out about the programs offered to help feed the hungry. Scouts can volunteer to help. Learn more about Second Harvest at www.feedoc.org.
